With the help of Final Command Ministries, we created a few evaluation questions for your team and movements to ask. This tool is meant to aid you as you raise disciple makers in your movements!

1. Pray & Fast Regularly

- ▶ How are we developing our team to hear from God before we plan?
- ▶ How are we cultivating a culture of prayer and fasting in our movement which leads to praying daily? Fasting weekly?



2. Serve Strategically

- ▶ After listening to God, where is He leading us to serve?
- ▶ Is this opportunity strategic? Does it answer the “prayers”, the longings, of the lost? Does it fill their deepest needs?
- ▶ How do the events that we host serve the needs of students/faculty?



3. Find Persons of Peace

Person of Peace: A person whom God has prepared to be receptive to the gospel before we arrive, and/or will open us to their community (Luke 10).

- ▶ As we serve strategically, are we praying for God to surface persons of peace?
- ▶ What is our team doing to identify persons of peace?



4. Start Discovery Bible Study

- ▶ After identifying persons of peace, are we inviting them into DBS in their community’s familiar places (where they live and hang out)?
- ▶ How are we challenging persons of peace to invite their oikos (at least 5 friends/family in their circle of influence) to join the DBS?
- ▶ How are we utilizing Bridges resources in training the DBS process?



5. Embrace Multiplication

- ▶ How are we equipping students/faculty to engage with lost friends and family through Discovery Bible Studies?
- ▶ How are we training engaged disciples in each of these elements?
- ▶ How do we prioritize *Faithful-Available-Teachable* student/faculty who want to make disciples?
