

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. What are some of your initial thoughts and emotions related to the challenges MBBs may face in their faith journey?
2. Your MBB student has been a believer for four months. He is visiting his home country for four weeks this summer and is concerned about whether he should tell his family about his decision or hide it from them for now. How would you counsel him?
3. Which Bible verses or passages would you use when discussing the reality of persecution with an MBB?
4. How would you counsel an MBB whom you're discipling who struggles with accepting singleness, or who is being pressured to marry a nonbeliever?
5. How would you go about making connections between a MBB student and other MBBs? How about with those back in his or her home country?
6. What are some things that you would be sure to do if an MBB student whom you are discipling is returning home in six months? Three months?
7. What does it look like to balance the reality of personal security concerns, while also encouraging MBB students to take steps of faith, such as identifying as a Christian or sharing their faith?
