

STUDENT LEADERSHIP SERVANT TEAMS



Evangelistic Outreach Team

Purpose: Facilitate a community for believing students to meet and connect with non-believing students in order to open doors for relationships and spiritual conversations

- Brainstorm and try new ideas to expand or launch new movements (i.e. muslim students, new departments, different residence halls)
- Decide the date and the content of the events (i.e. holiday party, cultural workshop, apologetic forum, community service, game night) and communicate with communications team to promote and invite
- Delegate roles/responsibilities to others (staff, students, volunteers)
- Follow up on new contacts from outreach events

Communications Team

Purpose: Facilitate and engage with international students through online platforms and maintain clear communications among student leaders, campus administration, and staff

- Communicate details with team coordinators to help reserve space and promote events
- Keep students updated about Bridges activities through emails, WeChat, Facebook, and other social media
- Familiar with school policy and coordinate with club treasurer to reserve places, apply funding
- Update students' contact info regularly

Prayer Team

Purpose: Emphasize the importance of prayer and call for a strong dependence on God in order to set a strong spiritual foundation for our ministry

- Create a culture of prayer on our team by encouraging leaders to focus on prayer and engage in prayer activities (i.e. prayer walk on campus, prayer chain, fasting, etc)
- Collect prayer requests from each leader or each Discovery Bible group to know what to pray for (i.e. Have a list of students that we pray for regularly)
- Set a regular time(s) for corporate prayer and invite other Christians to join

Community/Training Team

Purpose: Build a community of Christian students to be trained and equipped in sharing their faith and leading spiritual movements

- Create a community to encourage one another and keep each other accountable
- Decide the time, place, and content for leadership meetings and development time
- Coordinate Discovery Bible Groups and provide trainings for the facilitators

*There may be other servant teams that would make sense for your movement or you may want to start with a few servant teams as you grow your student leadership team.
